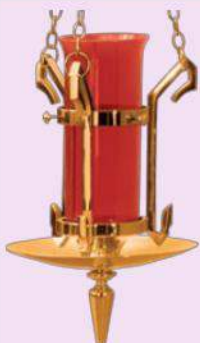

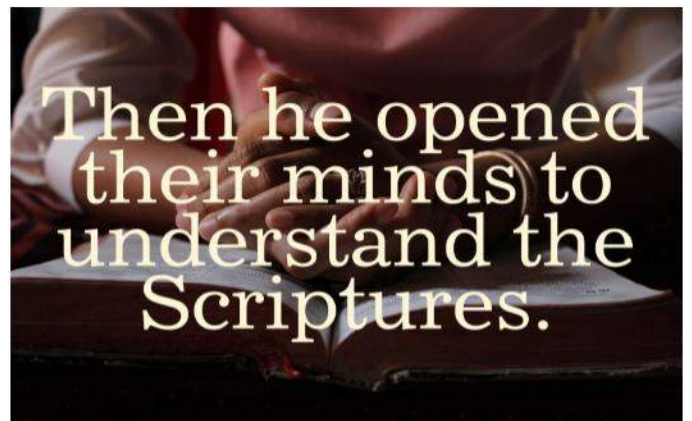

CATECHETICAL † CORNER

CELEBRATING EASTER – HOW IS THE DATE FOR EASTER SUNDAY DETERMINED?

Jesus rose from the dead on the first Sunday following the Jewish feast of Passover. The date of Passover is a complicated thing. Theoretically, the date should be the 14th of the Jewish month of Nisan, and it should correspond to a full moon (the Jewish calendar being partly lunar). In practice, it didn't always work out that way. The month-moon cycles got out of synch, and sometimes feasts would be held on a "liturgical" full moon even when it was not an astronomical full moon. As a result, rabbis periodically had to announce when Passover would be celebrated.

Christians didn't like being dependent on the pronouncements of rabbis for how to celebrate Christian feasts, so they came up with another way of determining the date. They decided that Easter would be celebrated on the first Sunday *after* (never *on*) the Paschal full moon.

Theoretically, the Paschal full moon is the first full moon occurring on or after the spring equinox. This day, however, can be reckoned in different ways. One way is by looking at the sky, which yields the *astronomical* spring equinox. But since this shifts from year to year, most people follow the *calendrical* spring equinox, which is reckoned as March 21.

On the Gregorian calendar (the one that we use), Easter is the first Sunday *after* the Paschal full moon, which is the first full moon *on* or *after* March 21. Thus, Easter always falls between March 22 and April 25.

"This is the day which the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it" (Psalm 118:24) and our Sunday rest allows us time and space to enter into a period of family recreation and refreshment, limited not only to our nuclear families at home, but also in a spirit of charity and unity with the parish family, and, ultimately, with the whole Church, visible in common fraternity and worship of Almighty God.

Live It!

- Set aside time to be with family on Sundays, share a meal as a household, and engage in recreation together. Is there a family member you haven't connected with for a while? Take the time to call, text, email, or contact the person in some way.
- Think of a strength or gift that each family member possesses and give thanks to God for that person.
- Take time during the week to read and reflect on the readings for the upcoming Sunday and discuss as a family.

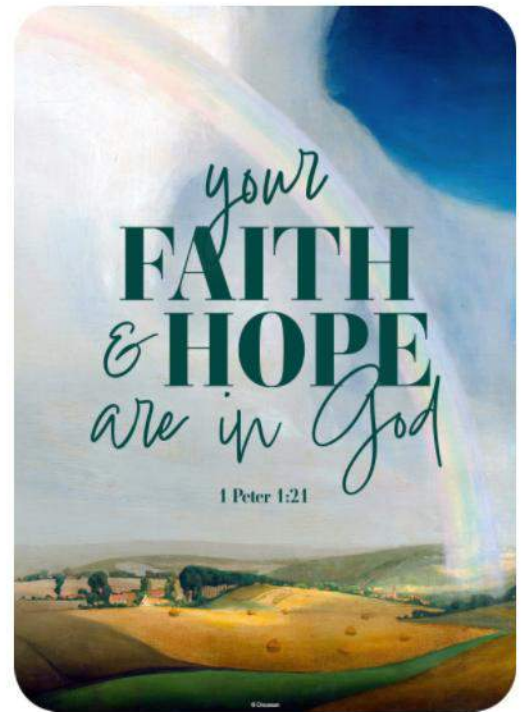
